

Chapter 13, Article 51(i) states:

Loudspeakers, amplifiers for advertising, etc. No person shall operate or permit the use or operation of any loudspeaker, sound amplifier, or other device for the production or reproduction of sound on a street or other public place for the purpose of commercial advertising or attracting the attention of the public to any commercial establishment or vehicle, without a written permit from the city. Application shall be made on forms provided by the city. The application shall require the hours and location of the proposed use. If the proposed use complies with this article and other ordinances, the permit shall be granted. Permit fees shall be established in Chapter 4 of the Chanhassen City Code.

A law enforcement supervisor will review permit applications. If the proposed use complies with this ordinance and other applicable ordinances of the City, the permit shall be granted.

The permit holder is responsible for maintaining the event noise at a reasonable level. A law enforcement officer may order the event noise level to be reduced or eliminated if the noise level disturbs others.
