





Handicap accessible ramp down to Carver Beach on Lotus Lake is needed

Property taxes are too high already. We're already looking at a large, upcoming assessment for street repairs. We could not afford any more increase in property taxes for new amenities.

We have lived in Chanhassen for almost 20 years and remain shocked that we don't have an indoor ice rink, pool, or indoor walking track here. Even though our children are now grown and no longer living in Minnesota, we still would like to see these enhancements made - for our own good as active adults and for the benefit of younger families.

Reservable indoor Pickleball courts!

Love all the trails & parks-- thank you! Add stop signs by busy parks and trails-- like the Roundhouse Park. Repair out of order street lights-- at Roundhouse Park. Maintain & repair sidewalks promptly. Add native plants and grasses to increase natural habitat. Stop using chemicals (pesticides) at the parks-- this is where our children play & native animals need to survive.

Our ball and soccer fields are not up to par compared to other cities of our size. We need better fields and flush bathrooms with concession options.

LOVE the idea of permanent bathrooms at parks! This would be very helpful for families with children who can be unpredictable with their bathroom needs! ©

Expand fishing piers and bank areas for fishing

We are Sr's and use ECC daily since Chan does not have facilities. How much more we could spend may depend on what out property tax increase looks like...

Park & Rec does a good job of providing a variety of interesting opportunities for kids thru seniors but why not consider leaving some of the events to the private sector/businesses community rather than competing with them on certain holidays such as Halloween and Christmas.

Currently our family doesn't go to the Chan Rex center because of the out dated facilities. If that were to get renovated, we would look into becoming members.

I think the reimagined rec center with pools and senior center, indoor running tracks etc all in one place, is one effective way to deliver on the "city for life" dream. We just have to figure out a way to pay for it.. I also think that an event center as part of the complex could generate income for the city. Tie the EDC to the event center and have them find customers who would rent the space for events such as receptions and business meetings...

I think with our growing community, having an improved community center is something to definitely consider. It just doesn't meet the expectations of what a community center should be and because of that, it is not used by many who live here.

Let's emphasize our parks and recreation systems to truly make this the best city to live in. Upgrade what we currently have and create new opportunities at all parks in the system, eventually. Many nearby cities are building inclusive playgrounds that allow accessibility for everyone. Lake Ann would be a good location for that. Better parks with more amenities will get more usage. People don't like to use old and poorly maintained facilities.

We currently take swimming lessons through the City of Eden Prairie, and other camps through EP or Minnetonka district. It would be awesome to see an improvement in offerings through the City of Chanhassen. I would love to spend the money supporting Chanhassen, not another city. Also, Sugarbush Park is in need of an upgrade for sure!

Chanhassen needs to continue to maintain and expand its "green space" every chance possible, but acquiring land (such as the Lake Ann acreage) is useless unless we install the promised trails.

An outdoor pool would be awesome

Chanhassen falls well behind our neighboring communities like Eden Prairie and Minnetonka for parks/rec. While we have some great neighborhood parks, even those are often not supported by sidewalks (making them not walkable from the communities they are intended to serve) and don't have adequate bathroom facilities. Families should feel safe going to and from parks as well as enjoying them. Same with our trails which are often crumbling and unsafe for use (potholes, roots, etc). Thank you for taking the time to assess our recreational space. The more we can bring our community together through shared spaces the stronger we will be; more likely people are to stay.

Maybe better enforcement of keeping dogs in yards and on leashes by public trails? It's scary for me with toddlers when owners think they have control (but don't) of their dogs. Have a couple spots of trails near Chan HS where dogs don't stay in their yards.

As "the #1 place to live", it is embarrassing that we don't have a better "rec" center. We are members at Chaska Community Center because our Rec Center does not have adequate amenities. Chanhassen NEEDS to build a stand alone rec center with full amenities!

Trail maintenance (clean-up and resurfacing) are #1 priority. The trail system is one of Chanhassen's largest advantages and if they deteriorate, it will become a large negative disadvantage.

With the land available around the current Rec Center, I think the city should consider an expansion of the current Rec Center. Neighboring communities make their Rec Center a destination while the Current Chan Rec Center offers the basics.

I am concerned that the Lake Ann trail expansion could take on a life of it's own. I would prefer a narrower trail made of agrilime ir similar material vs. an asphalt trail that would potentially contaminate the lakes and could become a maintenance headache. A smaller simple bridge would also be better vs. a large contraption that would detract from the natural setting that the park currently has.

Not sure what timeline is for trail system near Lennar development, but looking forward to that.

Thank you to all our City Workers, Committees, and Volunteers who make Chan great place to live and play in!

Love the bike trails and fully support any upgrades to those. We will also start using the senior center more and expect that as our population ages, this will be greater need.

Inflation is an obvious concern and it seems to be rising rapidly, therefore, I do not believe this is a good time to be spending money on 'new' things (which will also cost money to maintain). I'd say we should be working on improving/fixing/maintaining what we already have.

We currently pay to use Eden Prairie Community Center as the facility as a nice gym and fantastic pools. Would definitely switch over the the Chanhassen one if they had a lap pool. Lake Ann is a wilderness hidden gem, would hate for it to be ruined by changing it too much.

An expanded rec center, indoor ice or a pool are big projects with large annual maintenance cost. In addition, the cost to build is very high at this time. It is not an opportune time to undertake a large construction project of this type.

With our winter being so long, we need more indoor tennis courts. We could also use a few outdoor tennis courts (maybe hire tennis trainers etc?)

The Rec Center is a joke. We should have a true "Community Center"

I strongly support a new recreation center. It needs an Indoor/outdoor 50 meter pool and an indoor outdoor play pool with slides. This will pay for itself with local swim teams and lessons. I would also consider additional kids amenities bounce gym or climbing wall. Finally, I'd consider an indoor soccer / football field or tennis courts.

What is going on with the trail at Rice marsh lake?

Chanhassen has beautiful parks... I hope we can keep them.

I feel very fortunate to live in a community that is always looking to add value to living in such a beautiful and giving community. Lake Ann is a beautiful hidden gem with a number of unique zones to enjoy. Adding an indoor ice option would put us on par with Chaska, Minnetonka, and Victoria for community amenities.

An indoor facility that has a walking track and an indoor ice arena would be a welcome addition to Chanhassen. An indoor pool would be nice too!

Being no parking is allowed on Coulter Blvd, a small parking area on Coulter, like for say 10 cars. There's a spot on the South side between Galpin Blvd and Century Blvd. That or shift the yellow strip 4-5' to 1 side and allow parking on 1 side of Coulter. Doing so would allow more access to the natural areas and trails there.

Consider other facilities nearby and their cost. For example, LifeTime at approximately \$150/month. And the amenities at Lake Minnewashta Park which is free, and the Landscape Arboretum.
