










IDENTIFICATION OF SAFETY GLAZING



SAFETY GLAZING IN DOORS REQUIRED IN ALL LOCATIONS SHOWN










IS A WALL OR PANEL AT LEAST 60 INCHES IN HEIGHT SEPARATING





SAFETY GLAZING IN WINDOWS





IF THE WINDOW HAS A BAR OR RAIL MOUNTED 34-38" ABOVE THE PLANE OF THE WALKING SURFACE, SAFETY GLAZING IS NOT REQUIRED. THE BAR OR RAIL MUST BE AT LEAST 1 1/2" THICK AND NOT CONTACT THE GLASS.
