An individual may ask the City of Chanhassen to release her/his private data to an outside entity or person. Because the City of Chanhassen does not have legal authority to release the data, it must get the individual's written informed consent.

Explanation of your rights and permission to release:

As a parent, you have the right to look at and get copies of public and private data about your minor children (under the age of 18). As a legally appointed guardian, you have the right to look at and get copies of public and private data about an individual for whom you are appointed guardian.

Minors have the right to ask us not to give data about them to their parent or guardian. You will need to put your request in writing and include the reasons why we should deny your parents access to the data. We will make the final decision about your request based on your best interests.
