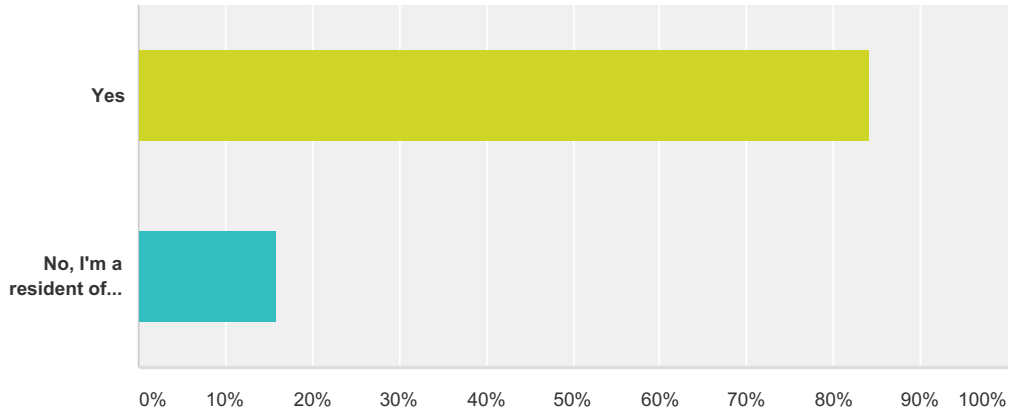

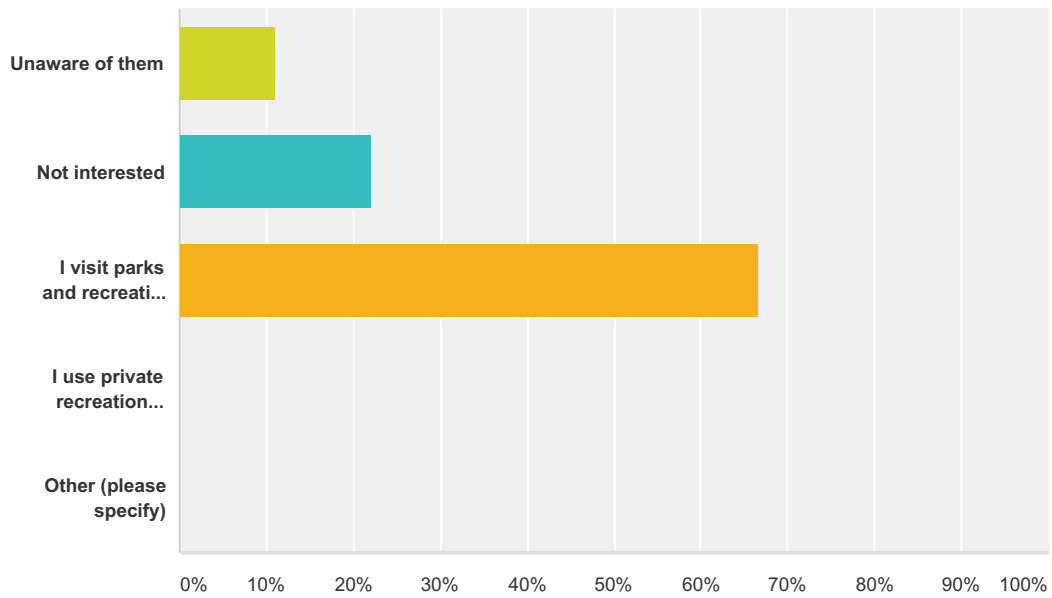

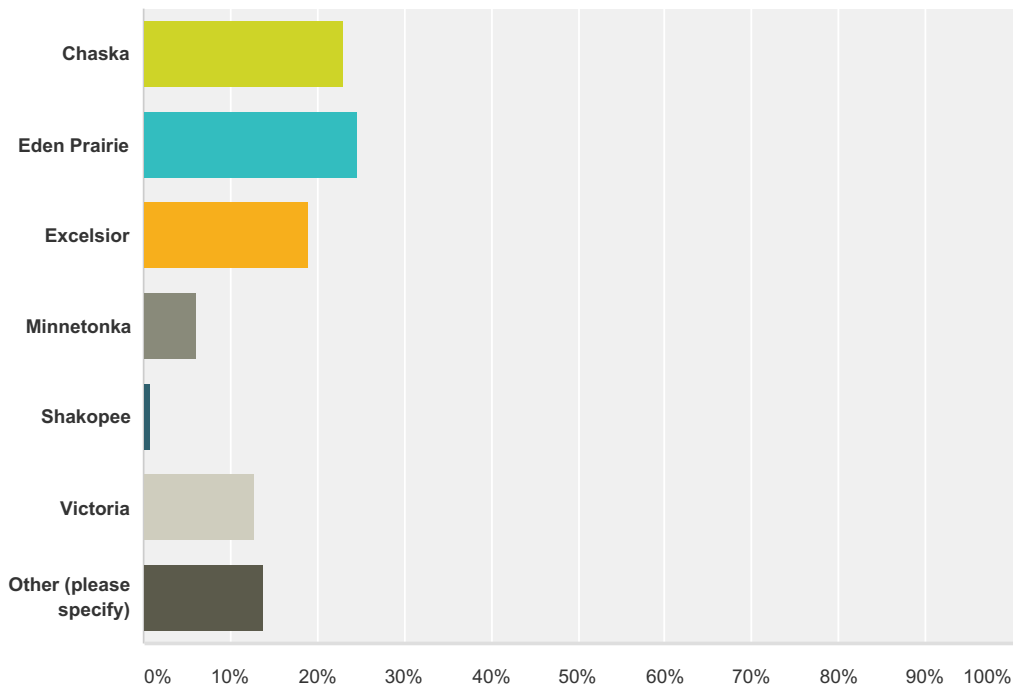

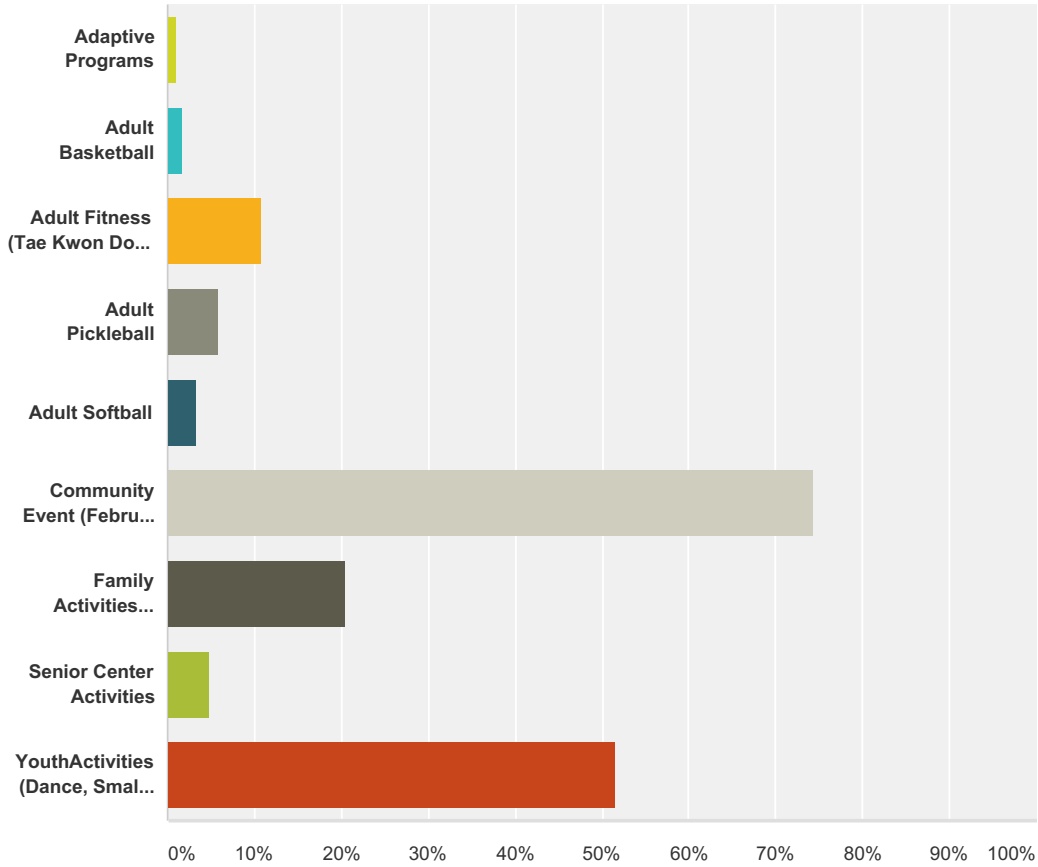

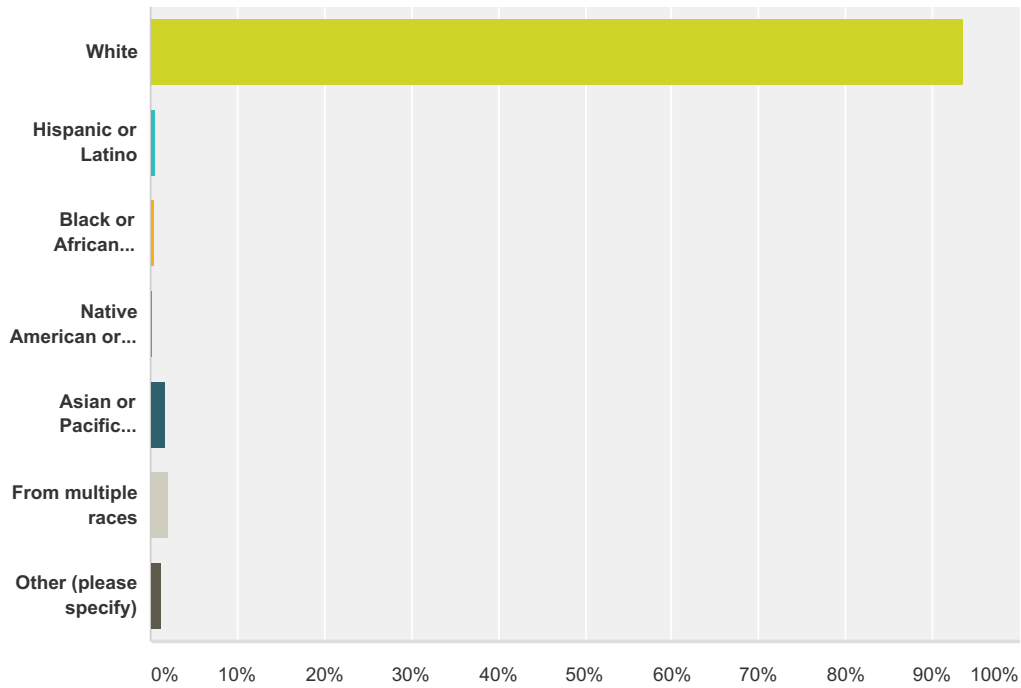

Q2 How often do you or a member of your household visit Chanhasen's Recreation Center?

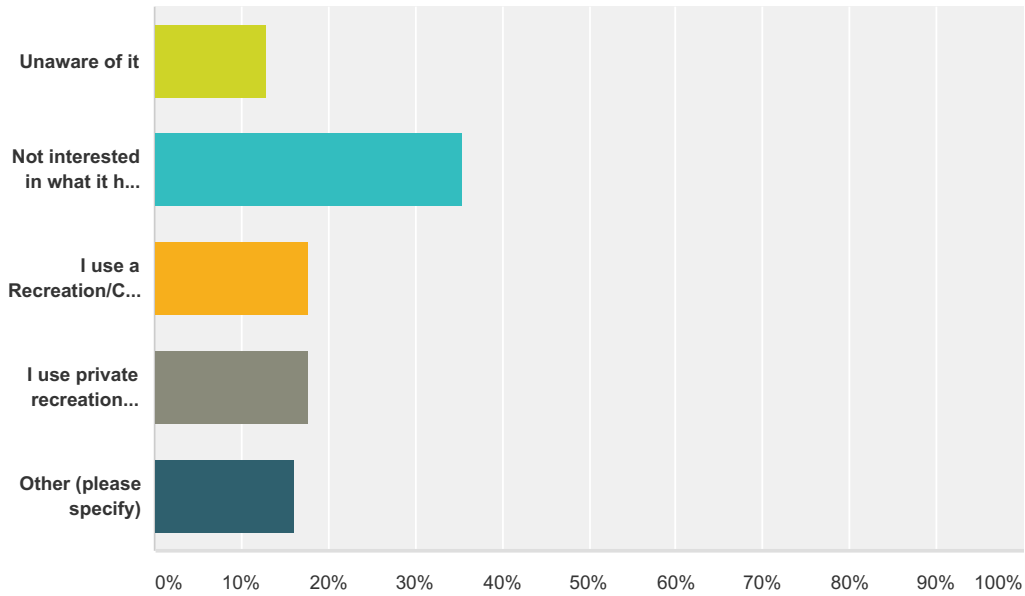

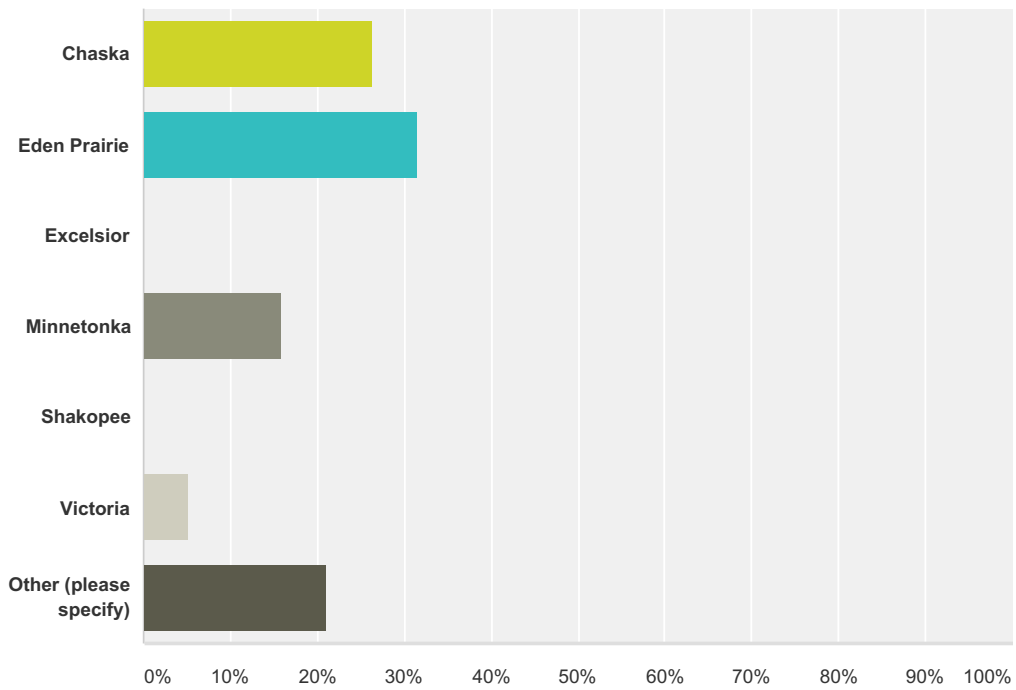

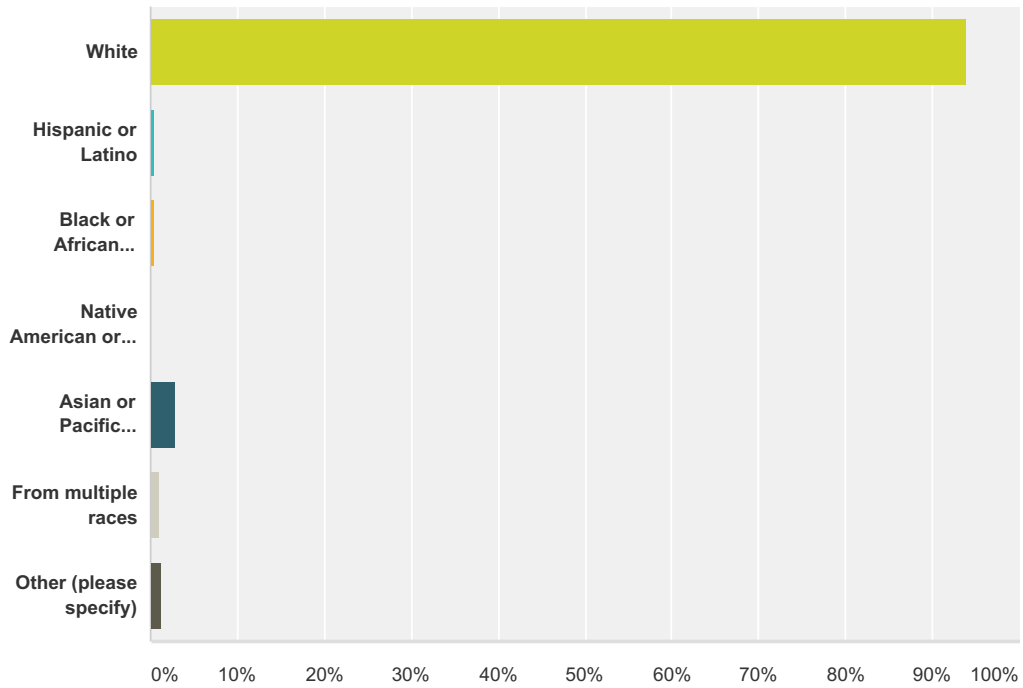

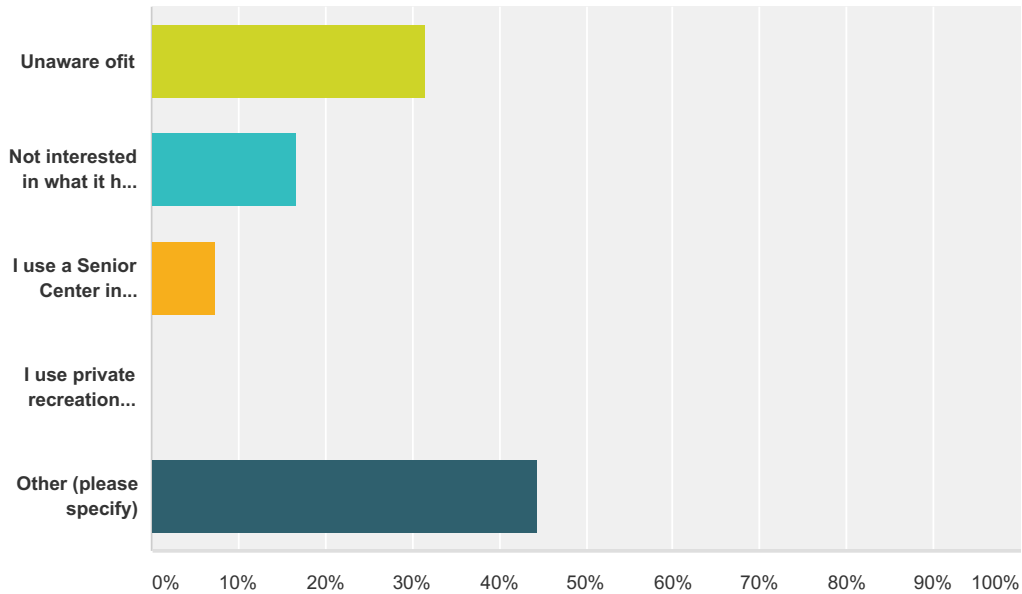

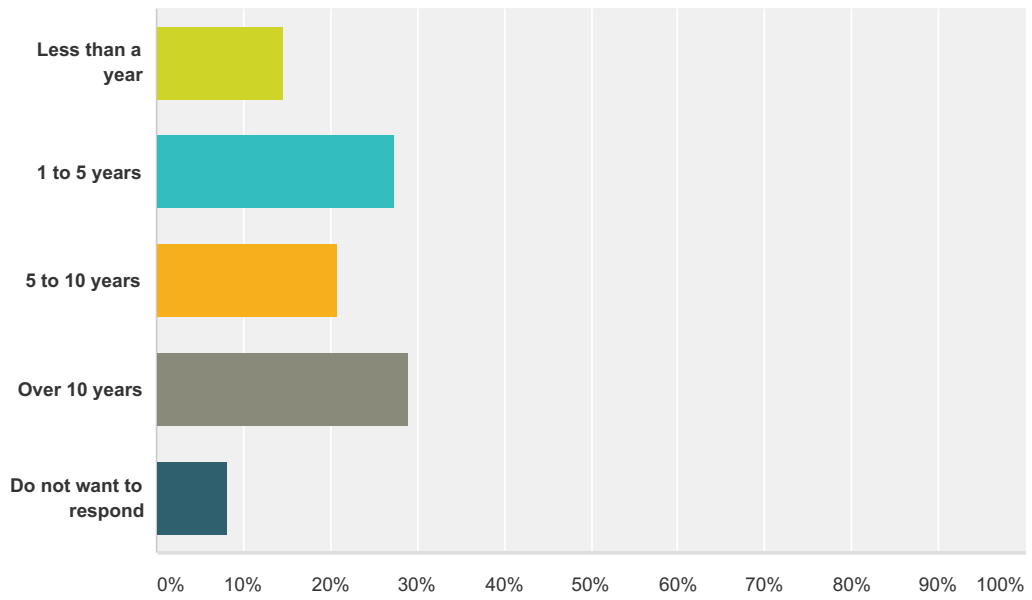

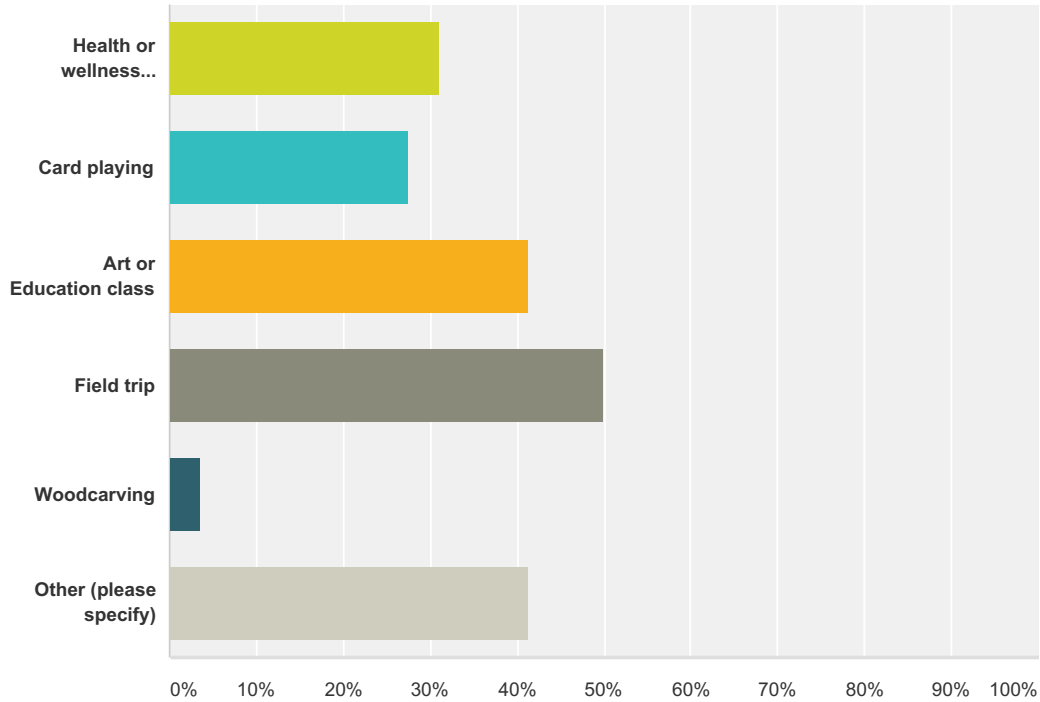

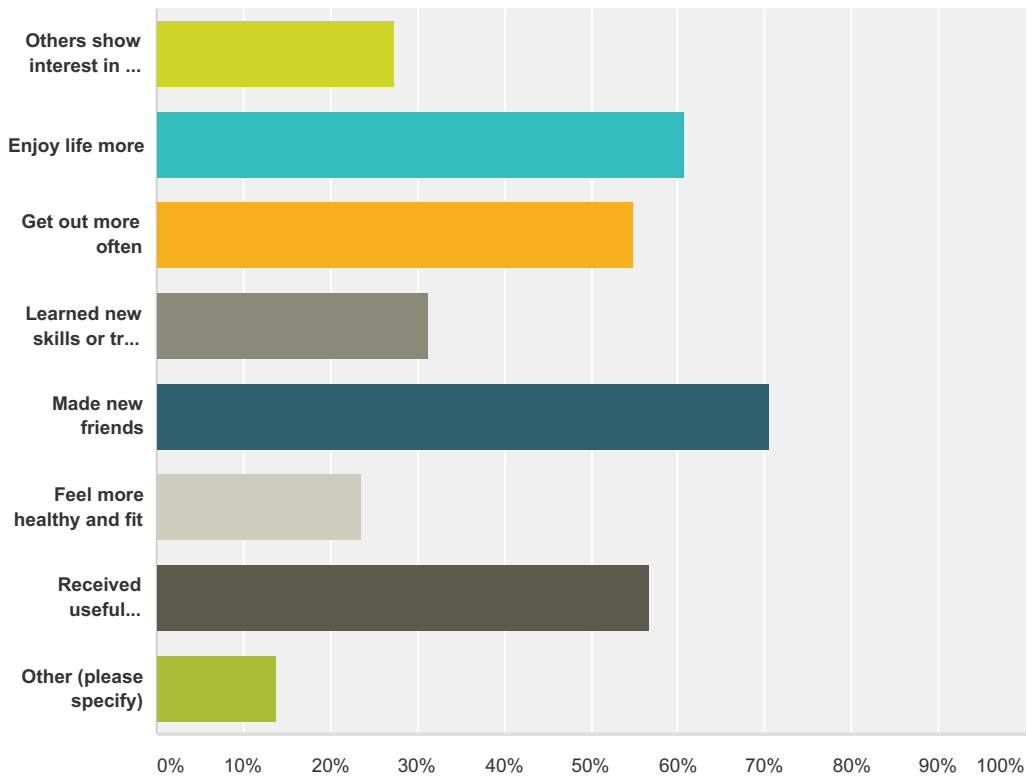

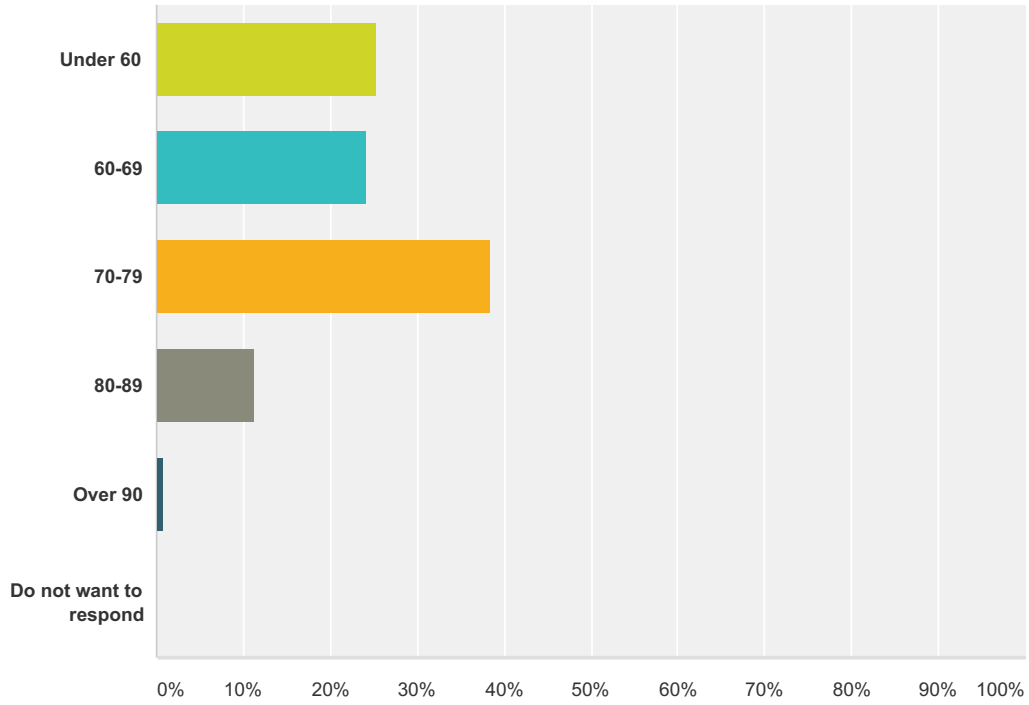

Q14 How old are you?

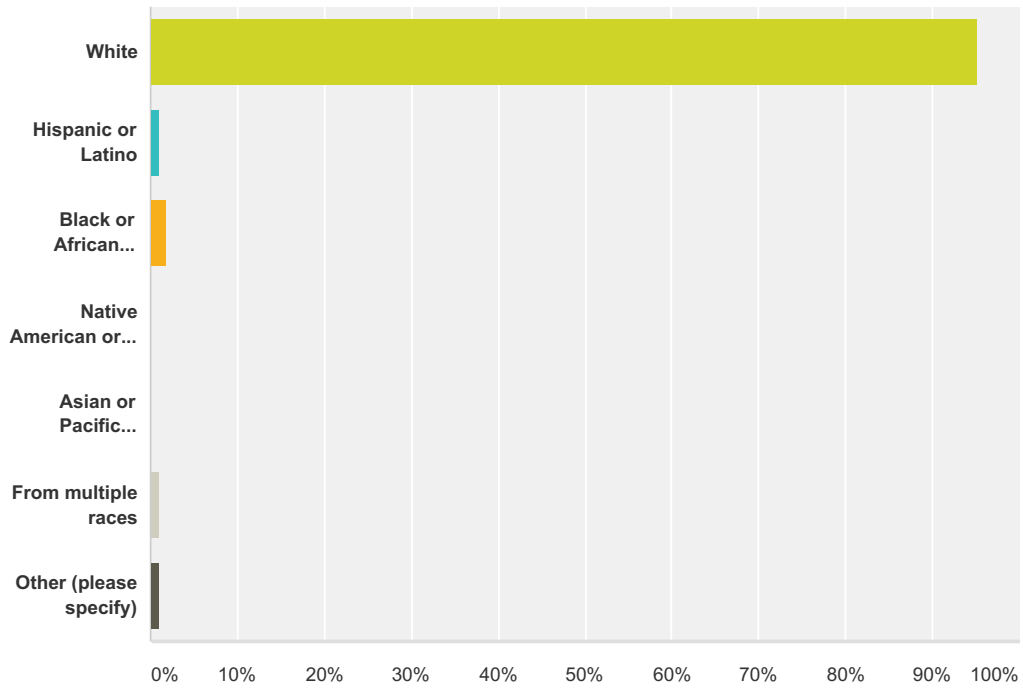
