

City of Chanhassen Training Information in Support of a Liquor License

Chanhassen City Code requires that no license shall be issued or renewed unless the applicant or license holder provide instruction to all employees in the legal requirements pertaining to the sale of alcoholic beverages, including, but not limited to, reviewing the law on the sale of alcoholic beverages, providing information on the health risks of using alcoholic beverages, and requiring employees to request identification from every customer who appears to be under twenty-seven (27) years of age.

No license shall be issued or renewed unless the applicant or license holder signs this form attesting that each employee has received training and instruction on the sale of alcoholic beverages and the date such training occurred. Training must be completed before an employee commences work and annually thereafter. The training shall include information that the sale of alcoholic beverages to minors is illegal, explains what proof of age is legally acceptable, and that a sale to a minor can subject the applicant or license holder and their employees to criminal liability.
